Blog 1: Your Bio

250 words and at least 2 photos

Write some important biographical information about yourself. You can use the 250 words that you wrote in your internship application. If this is your second or third internship, be sure to give updated info and photos.

***Due in the first week of your internship / apprenticeship*

Blog 2: What are you up to?

250 words and at least 2 photos

Describe what you are doing in your current internship/apprenticeship, plus 1-2 sentences stating a goal you have in communication (written or oral), leadership (in your work environment and your community), and a goal for expanding your professional network.

***Due by the time you finish 60-70 hours...must be posted before you receive your first stipend check*

Blog 3: Commonwealth Assets –

250 words and at least 2 photos

Complete the Commonwealth Mapping Exercise in your community, and then describe the most striking examples of commonwealth assets that you discovered.

***Due by the time you finish 130 hours – must be posted before your receive your second internship stipend or 3rd apprenticeship stipend*

Blog 4: Community Service

300 words and at least 2 photos

Describe your 10-hours of community service: what you did, why you chose the service project(s), what was most challenging for you, and how the experience impacted you and benefitted the community

***Due by the time you complete 180 hours*

Blog 5: Summary of Experience and Outcomes

400 words and at least 2 photos

Describe the highlights of your internship or apprenticeship: discuss the main projects, your successes, your main challenges, and your final outcomes. Also, devote a paragraph to describing how you achieved the 3 goals you wrote about in Blog 1: your communication goal, your leadership goal, and your professional network expansion goal.

***Due by the time you finish 200 hours of internship or 500 hours of apprenticeship—must be completed before you can receive your final stipend*
